




## Q2 Where do you primarily use FreeBSD? (Check only one)







### Q8 For about how long have you been using FreeBSD?




### Q14 Which firewalls do you use?



## Q15 When using FreeBSD outside of your job, approximately how many physical and virtual FreeBSD installations do you have?





## Q16 When using FreeBSD at work/school, approximately how many physical and virtual FreeBSD installations does the organization have?





## Q17 Ideally, FreeBSD major branches (or an LTS branch) will be supported for years (i.e. security fixes, critical bugs, packages).





## Q18 If the project were to shorten LTS below your ideal timeframe, would you pay for extended support?









### Q50 As far as you know, which of the following functions or roles does the FreeBSD Foundation serve? (Check all that apply)



## Q51 If the FreeBSD Foundation were to offer professional training classes for a nominal fee, what topics would you like to see? (Check all that apply)










